

Viewfinity Release Notes

These release notes apply to Viewfinity v. 3.0 (2.1.0.211)

New Features and Improvements:

Feature	Description
Patch Management	Integration with Microsoft WSUS. Viewfinity Patch Management enables IT administrators to deploy the latest Microsoft product updates to both Microsoft Windows Servers and Windows XP, Windows Vista and Windows 7 client operating systems.
Agent Deployment mechanism changed	New Deploy Agent mechanism (based on SCM instead of WMI, now only ports TCP ports 135, 139 and 445 need to be opened in order to use Auto agent deployment)
64-bit Viewfinity Agent for 64-bit platforms	Native 64 bit agent. In the previous version, 32 bit agent was used on 64 bit platforms
Dashboard	Customizable web panes show reporting information collected by the Viewfinity agent installed on all company assets. Most report in the Viewfinity console is available for display on the Viewfinity Dashboard.
Dual-mode of Remote Terminal (“console”-mode and “assistant”-mode).	Console mode can be used to initiate a new remote control session. Assistant mode connects to remote PC and shares the session with the end user.
White list (Start Normally) and “Child Processes”	Added the ability to handle “Child Processes” for Start Normally policy. New option is added prompting user to select how child processes should be permitted, blocked or handled by default policy.
Scripts support extended	Extended set of types of scripts to be supported for all Viewfinity’s features including Computer policy, Privilege Elevation, Application Policies, Start Normally Policy (.BAT;.CMD;.VBS;.VBE;.JS;.JSE;.WSF;.WSH).
Elevation Privilege & Block Policy enhancements	Support for wildcards in “Elevate Privileges” Policy (File and Path parameters). Block and start normally.

New Report added	Added " Unused Application" Report to show non-utilized software
Improved Reports	Removed zeros from "Software License & Usage Summary" and moved unused application summary to "Unused Software" report
Improved Reports performance	Improved performance of "Software License & Usage Summary" Report (charts are in sub-Reports now)
discontinued GUI support for IE 6.0	GUI in IE6 is not supported anymore (only IE7/8 are fully supported)
Improved Asset Inventory	1. Improved scanning of installed Applications 2. Re-implemented mechanism for Program icons retrieval in Asset Inventory
Improved Central Event Viewer	Re-implemented mechanism for Windows Event Log retrieval and improved performance
